Job hazard analysis (JHA) is a workplace assessment method used to identify and control unacceptable risks relating to the performance of job tasks. As a result of the introduction of Part 19 of the Canada Occupational Health and Safety Regulations, performance of JHA has become commonplace in organizations regulated under the Canada Labour Code, Part II. This module will instruct managers, supervisors and employers on the benefits of conducting a JHA, how to conduct a JHA and provide mechanisms to ensure consistency among JHA's.
